- Electronically logging, completing and tracking each request
- Scanning and printing relevant documents
- Supplies such as paper, envelopes, toner, equipment usage and postage

To offset the rising cost associated with processing, it is necessary that we receive payment prior to processing each request.

A complete medical record fee is:

A base fee of \$15.00 plus the per page charge as stated below.

You can elect to **only** get an "Abstract" of your child's medical records, which consists of: Office notes for the past two (2) years along with immunizations, labs, problem list, medication list etc. as these are usually sufficient to meet the needs of transferring to another practice, for a fee of \$10.00

The fee for medical records can be remitted by cash or check made payable to Quincy Pediatric Associates Inc. We also accept Visa and MasterCard.

Your request will be fulfilled upon receipt of payment.

GENERAL LAWS OF MASSACHUSETTS – PART I. ADMINISTRATION OF THE GOVERNMENT – TITLE XVI. – PUBLIC HEALTH CHAPTER 111. PUBLIC HEALTH – HOSPITALS Chapter 111: Section 70 Records of hospitals or clinics; custody; inspection; copies; fees

S.B. 642, an Act Regarding Medical Record Copying Fees was signed into law by Governor Romney on November 26, 2003 and took effect on July 1, 2004. This bill identifies reasonable fees and establishes acceptable charges for health information that will comply with both federal HIPAA and state regulatory requirements. The term reasonable fee established under this section may be adjusted to reflect the consumer price index (CPI) for medical care services, such that the base amount and the per page charge shall be increased by the proportional CPI in effect as of October of the calendar year in which the request is made, rounded to the nearest dollar. The new fee is as follows:

A base charge of not more than 15.00 dollars for each request for a medical record; a per page charge of not more than (0.50) cents for each of the first 100 pages of a medical record that is copied per request; and not more than (0.25) cents per page for each page in excess of 100 pages of a medical record that is copied per request and the cost of postage and mailing.
